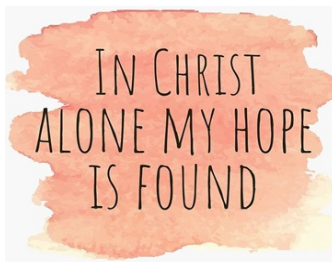

Join us this Thursday between the hours of 12pm and 2pm at the Welcome Inn Community Café; a free service which is open to all in our community.



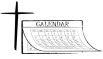
Highgate Care Home
