

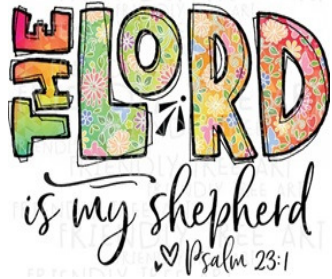

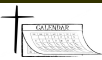
## Moderator's Presbytery Visit
