*Please be aware there will be no meetings of the Youth Club or the Bible Class the next two Sundays. Back to normal on the 14<sup>th</sup> April.*



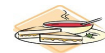
### Pre-5 Praise

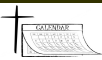
## Return of the Walkie Talkies
